1 a) From the north

From Dorsten on the B 224 or from the A2 motorway take exit no. 5 Essen/Gladbeck towards Essen-Stadtmitte via the B 224 (Gladbecker Straße), then turn right onto Berthold-Beitz-Boulevard and right again onto Bamlerstraße.

1 b) Via the A42 (Emscherschnellweg)

At the Essen-Nord junction (exit 13) take the B 224 towards Essen-Stadtmitte (Gladbecker Straße), then turn right into Berthold-Beitz-Boulevard and right again into Bamlerstraße.

2) From Düsseldorf via the A52

Take exit no. 30 Essen-Bergerhausen, go left onto Ruhrallee, at the next junction (Huttropstraße) turn right, drive along Huttropstraße, Oberschlesienstraße, Burggrafenstraße, Herzogstraße (bridge), Katzenbruchstraße and Grillostraße, turn right onto Segerothstraße and continue to

Bottroper Straße. Turn right into Berthold-Beitz-Boulevard and take the first left onto Bamlerstraße.

3 a) Via local public transport

From Essen's main railway station take the underground (U-Bahn) line U17 (towards Karlsplatz, Essen Ruhr) to "Bamlerstraße" (journey time approx. 5 minutes). Walk along "Berthold-Beitz-Boulevard" until you reach the OGE building at Bamlerstraße 1-5.

3 b) From Duisburg via the A40

Take exit 23 Essen-Zentrum, turn left onto Holsterhauser Straße, then left again at the next traffic lights onto Friedrichstraße (B224), drive along Friedrichstraße, Hans-Böckler-Straße and Grillostraße to the traffic lights at Segerotherstraße, then turn left onto Segerotherstraße and left again onto Bottroper Straße (B631) in the direction of Bottrop. At the second traffic light go right onto Berthold-Beitz-Boulevard and immediately left into Bamlerstraße.
